SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 74,  
L.D. 92, Bill, "An Act Relating to Private School Student Participation in Public School  
Cocurricular, Interscholastic and Extracurricular Activities"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title and before the first paragraph the  
following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the  
following:

**'Mandate preamble.** This measure requires one or more local units of government  
to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local  
revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to  
the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, 2/3 of all of the members elected to  
each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

### Fiscal Note

State Mandate - Exempted

#### State Mandates

##### Required Activity

Limits the ability of a public school principal or principal's designee to deny students enrolled in certain equivalent instruction programs from participating in its cocurricular, extracurricular and interscholastic activities.

##### Unit Affected

##### Local Cost

Insignificant statewide

Requires principal to provide written explanation to student or student's parent/guardian if approval is withheld.

School

Insignificant statewide

Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the state from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional costs.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment adds a Mandate Preamble to the bill.
