
8 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 97, L.D. 115, Bill, "An Act To Join in a
9 Prohibition on Motor Fuel Containing Corn-based Ethanol"

10 Amend the bill in section 1 in section §1457-B in subsection 2 in the first 3 lines
11 (page 1, lines 8 to 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2 of the other New England
12 states, Connecticut, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Vermont," and
13 inserting the following: '10 other states or a number of states with a collective population
14 of 30,000,000'

15 Amend the bill in section 1 in §1457-B in subsection 2 in the next to the last line
16 (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2 other New England states" and
17 inserting the following: '10 other states or a number of states having a collective
18 population of 30,000,000'

19 SUMMARY

20 This amendment changes the number of states required for the corn-based ethanol
21 prohibition to take effect from 2 other New England states to 10 states or a number of
22 states with a collective population of 30,000,000.
