COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 119, L.D. 144, Bill, "An Act To Remove the Requirement That a Person Training Dogs on Sundays Possess a Valid Hunting License"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §12051, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

6. Effect of revocation. A person may not train dogs under this section if that person has a suspended or revoked license pursuant to section 10902.'

This amendment adds a provision to the bill that makes a person ineligible to train dogs on wild birds and wild animals if that person has a suspended or revoked hunting license.
