9 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 126, L.D. 151, Bill, "An Act To Allow 10 2 Eligible Organizations To Jointly Hold a Game of Beano or Bingo"

11 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the 12 summary and inserting the following:

13 'Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §314, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1997, c. 684, §1, is further
14 amended to read:

15 The fee for such a license to any nonprofit organization is \$12.00 for each calendar 16 week, or portion thereof, that the amusement is to be operated, or the license may be 17 issued for a calendar month for a fee of \$36.00 or a calendar year for a fee of \$400. A 18 special per-game license may be issued to any gualified nonprofit organization for the 19 purposes of operating a game of "beano" or "bingo" for a fee of \$5.00. The special per-20 game license may not be issued more than 6 times to any one organization in a calendar 21 year. All license fees must be paid to the Treasurer of State to be credited to the General 22 Fund. A license is not assignable or transferable. Nothing contained in this section may 23 be construed to prohibit any volunteer fire department or any agricultural fair association 24 or bona fide nonprofit charitable, educational, political, civic, recreational, fraternal, 25 patriotic, religious, veterans' organization or auxiliary of any of them from obtaining 26 licenses for a period not to exceed 6 months on one application. No more than one 27 license may be issued to any organization for any one period. No Except as provided in 28 section 315-A, no more than one licensee may operate or conduct a game of "beano" or 29 "bingo" on the same premises on the same date.

- 30 Sec. 2. 17 MRSA §315-A is enacted to read:
- 31 §315-A. Limited dual beano license
- 32 The Chief of the State Police may issue a limited dual beano license to 2 33 organizations eligible for a regular license to conduct a game of beano. A limited dual 34 beano license permits 2 organizations to conduct beano jointly on the same date and at 35 the same location. An organization may only conduct beano under the authority of a dual

license on 2 occasions during a calendar year. The following provisions apply to licensure under this section.

1. Application. The 2 organizations wishing to conduct beano jointly shall submit an application to the Chief of the State Police in a manner prescribed by the chief.

2. Lead applicant. One organization must be identified as the lead applicant and acknowledge responsibility for any violation of the laws or rules governing beano committed during the conduct of the game.

3. Disposition of revenue. Revenue received from the conduct of the game must be divided in equal amounts between both organizations. Each organization shall file a disposition of funds report as if that organization had conducted beano independently. 10

4. License fee. The license fee for a limited dual beano license is \$12.

12 5. Sealed tickets. A limited dual beano license does not authorize the licensed 13 organizations to sell sealed tickets jointly.

6. Application of other laws. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the provisions of this chapter and rules adopted in accordance with this chapter apply to beano games conducted under a limited dual beano license.' 16

SUMMARY

18 This amendment replaces the bill and is the majority report of the committee. It 19 establishes a limited dual beano license that permits 2 organizations eligible to conduct 20 beano to conduct a game at the same location on the same date. It provides that an 21 organization that operates beano under a limited dual beano license may only do so up to 22 2 times per year. Organizations that apply for a limited dual bean license must identify 23 a lead applicant who acknowledges responsibility for any violation of laws or rules 24 during the game. The limited dual beano license does not authorize the sale of sealed 25 tickets.
