a Traffic Infraction Who Pay Fines by Waiver**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2601, sub-§11** is enacted to read:

3 **11. Traffic summonses; fine reduced.** For a person who has received a Violation
4 Summons and Complaint for a traffic infraction, if the person files with the violations
5 bureau a written answer that does not contest the traffic infraction, the fine is reduced by
6 10%.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill provides that if a person files a written answer to the judicial branch's
9 violations bureau that does not contest a traffic infraction, the fine is reduced by 10%.
