SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 183, L.D. 222, Bill, "An Act Designating the Chief of the State Police as the Only Issuing Authority of a Permit To Carry a Concealed Handgun"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 14 and inserting the following:

Sec. 14. Transfer from Gambling Control Board Other Special Revenue Funds. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer \$157,175 no later than August 1, 2014 from the Gambling Control Board, Other Special Revenue Funds account to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund.

Sec. 15. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

PUBLIC SAFETY, DEPARTMENT OF

Licensing and Enforcement - Public Safety 0712

Initiative: Provides an allocation of concealed handgun permit fees for 2 Office Associate II positions and one State Police Detective position to maintain a confidential database of concealed handgun permits and to perform record checks on applicants.
