2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §456-H is enacted to read:
3	§456-H. Renewable energy registration plates
4 5 6 7	The Secretary of State shall issue renewable energy registration plates beginning June 1, 2014 in accordance with this section. Renewable energy registration plates are not required for registration of a motor vehicle but are to allow citizens to participate voluntarily to fund a program to benefit programs to support renewable energy.
8 9 10 11 12 13	1. Renewable energy registration plate. The Secretary of State, upon receiving an application and evidence of payment of the excise tax required by Title 36, section 1482, the registration fee required by section 501 and the administrative fee and voluntary contribution provided for in subsection 2, shall issue a registration certificate and a set of renewable energy registration plates to be used in lieu of regular registration plates. These plates must bear identification numbers and letters.
14 15 16 17 18	2. Administrative fee and contribution to special programs. A person may contribute to the Renewable Energy Special Programs Fund established by the Treasurer of State pursuant to subsection 7 by applying for the renewable energy registration plates and submitting, in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fee, a sum of \$20 credited as follows:
19 20	A. Nine dollars to the Renewable Energy Special Programs Fund established by the Treasurer of State in subsection 7;
21	B. Ten dollars to the Highway Fund for administrative and production costs; and
22	C. One dollar to the Specialty License Plate Fund established under section 469.
23 24 25 26 27	3. Design. A sponsor must submit a design for the renewable energy registration plate to the Secretary of State for approval or modification in accordance with section 468, subsection 5. The Secretary of State shall provide the final design to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters prior to manufacture of the plates.
28 29 30	4. Duplicate plates prohibited. The Secretary of State shall issue renewable energy registration plates in a 3-number and 3-letter combination sequence. Vanity plates may not duplicate vanity plates issued in another class of plate.
31 32 33	5. Weight limit. Renewable energy registration plates may be issued for a motor vehicle that does not exceed 10,000 pounds. A motor vehicle that exceeds 6,000 pounds is subject to the fees in section 504.
34 35 36	<b>6. Renewal fee.</b> In addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fee prescribed by law, the annual renewal contribution for renewable energy registration plates is \$15, which must be deposited with the Treasurer of State and credited as follows:
37 38	A. Nine dollars to the Renewable Energy Special Programs Fund established by the Treasurer of State in subsection 7:

1	B. Five dollars to the Highway Fund for administrative and production costs; and
2	C. One dollar to the Specialty License Plate Fund established under section 469.
3 4 5	7. Special fund established. The Treasurer of State shall establish the Renewable Energy Special Programs Fund to increase funding to programs that support renewable energy.
6 7 8	<b>8. Transfer of fees.</b> On a quarterly basis, the Secretary of State shall transfer the revenue from the issuance and renewal of the renewable energy registration plates to the Treasurer of State for deposit and crediting pursuant to subsections 2 and 6.
9	SUMMARY
10 11	This bill establishes a specialty license plate to increase funding for renewable energy programs.
