HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 72,
L.D. 236, Bill, "An Act To Protect the Privacy of Citizens from Domestic Unmanned
Aerial Vehicle Use"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4502 by inserting after subsection 1 the
following:

2. Moratorium. Before July 1, 2015, a law enforcement agency may not use an
unmanned aerial vehicle except as provided in section 4503, subsection 1.

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4502 by renumbering the subsections to read
consecutively.

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4504 in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 3,
line 8 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2" and inserting the following: '3'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4504 in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 3,
line 11 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2" and inserting the following: '3'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4504 in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 3,
line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2" and inserting the following: '3'

SUMMARY

This amendment imposes a moratorium until July 1, 2015 on the use of unmanned
aerial vehicles by law enforcement agencies. The moratorium does not apply to specified
emergency situations.
