1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA c. 805, sub-c. 3, art. 1,** as amended, is repealed.

3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill eliminates the commercial standard for Maine white-cedar shingles, a
5 program that has no funding and that has not been used for at least 20 years.
