COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 201, L.D. 292

SUMMARY

This amendment is the unanimous report of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. It replaces the bill with a resolve that directs the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to develop a plan for the protection of the public health from mosquito-borne diseases, in cooperation with appropriate personnel from the Department of Health and Human Services. The resolve also requires that the department report on its plan to the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry by December 15, 2013 and authorizes the committee to report out a bill on the plan to the Second Regular Session of the 126th Legislature.
