COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 219, L.D. 310, Bill, "An Act To Exempt Persons 70 Years of Age and Older from Jury Duty at Their Discretion"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Exempt Persons 80 Years of Age and Older from Jury Duty at Their Discretion'

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph C in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "70" and inserting the following: '80'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the age at which a person may be excused from jury service if they do not wish to serve on a jury from 70 years of age or older as in the bill to 80 years of age or older.
