HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 255,
L.D. 380, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Law Concerning the Threatening Display of
Dangerous Weapons"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the first line
(page 1, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "dangerous or deadly
weapon" and inserting the following: 'firearm'

SUMMARY

This amendment limits the requirement that a person provide that person's name,
address and date of birth to a law enforcement officer to a person in possession of a
firearm, instead of a dangerous or deadly weapon as provided in the committee
amendment.
