5 **Maine Commission on Indigent Legal Services Z112**

6 Initiative: Provides funds to increase reimbursement for indigent legal services from \$50
7 per hour to \$70 per hour effective October 1, 2013 and an increase to \$75 per hour
8 effective July 1, 2014.

15 This bill provides a General Fund appropriation of \$3,490,209 in fiscal year 2013-14

18 per hour effective October 1, 2013 and to \$75 per hour effective July 1, 2014.
