1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1751, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

3 **5. Antique autos.** Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 2, an antique auto
4 registered under section 457 must receive an annual inspection based upon standards
5 determined by the Chief of the State Police. The Chief of the State Police may adopt
6 rules to carry out the purposes of this subsection. Rules adopted pursuant to this
7 subsection are routine technical rules pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

8 **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1752, sub-§3,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and
9 affected by Pt. B, §5, is repealed.

10 **SUMMARY**

11 Current law exempts antique autos from motor vehicle inspections. This bill requires
12 antique autos to be inspected based upon standards determined by the Chief of the State
13 Police.
