1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11453, sub-§1**, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2 and
3 affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

4 **1. Unlawfully driving deer.** A person may not participate in a hunt for deer during
5 which an organized or planned effort is made to drive deer except that a group of 3 or
6 fewer persons may hunt together or a group of 6 or fewer persons may hunt together with
7 a registered Maine guide as long as they do not use noisemaking devices.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill allows a group of 6 or fewer persons to hunt together in a hunt for deer as
10 long as they are accompanied by a registered Maine guide and as long as they do not use
11 noisemaking devices.
