1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §601, sub-§2, ¶F**, as amended by PL 1995, c. 192, §1, is
3 repealed.

4 **SUMMARY**

5 This bill allows full-time law enforcement officers that have a direct or indirect
6 benefit in a place of business to hold a liquor license if they meet all the other
7 requirements.
