Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §1036, sub-§2, ¶F, as amended by PL 2005, c. 663, §12, is
 further amended to read:

- F. Two percent of the net slot machine income must be forwarded by the board to the
 University of Maine System Scholarship Fund created in Title 20-A, section 10909;
 and to the Board of Trustees of the Maine Maritime Academy to be applied by the
 board of trustees to fund its scholarship program. The slot machine income under
 this paragraph must be distributed as follows:
- 9 (1) The University of Maine System share is the total amount of the distribution 10 multiplied by the ratio of enrolled students in the system to the total number of 11 enrolled students both in the system and at the Maine Maritime Academy; and
- 12 (2) The Maine Maritime Academy share is the total amount of the distribution
 13 multiplied by the ratio of enrolled students at the academy to the total number of
 14 enrolled students both in the system and at the academy;
- 15 Sec. 2. 8 MRSA §1036, sub-§2-A, ¶B, as enacted by IB 2009, c. 2, §45, is
 16 further amended to read:
- B. Four percent of the net slot machine income must be forwarded by the board to
 the University of Maine System Scholarship Fund created in Title 20-A, section
 10909; and to the Board of Trustees of the Maine Maritime Academy to be applied
 by the board of trustees to fund its scholarship program. The slot machine income
 under this paragraph must be distributed as follows:
- 22(1) The University of Maine System share is the total amount of the distribution23multiplied by the ratio of enrolled students in the system to the total number of24enrolled students both in the system and at the Maine Maritime Academy; and
- (2) The Maine Maritime Academy share is the total amount of the distribution
 multiplied by the ratio of enrolled students at the academy to the total number of
 enrolled students both in the system and at the academy;

SUMMARY

This bill directs the Department of Public Safety, Gambling Control Board to forward revenue from slot machines operated by a casino operator and by a slot machine operator to the Board of Trustees of the Maine Maritime Academy to help fund its scholarships program.
