Removal of specific locations from the expedited permitting area 16 The Maine Land Use Planning Commission may remove specific locations from the 17 expedited permitting area in accordance with this section and rules adopted by the Maine 18 Land Use Planning Commission. Rules adopted under this section must include, but are 19 not limited to, provisions that: 20 1. Process. Establish a process to demonstrate that the removal of the specific location is supported by the registered voters within the specific location. The process 21 22 must include: 23 A. A public hearing at which supporters and opponents are permitted to speak. Speakers at the public hearing are not required to be residents of the specific location; 24 25 26 B. A petition process that requires that the petition: (1) Clearly state the boundaries of the specific location being proposed for 27 28 removal; (2) Clearly state that those signing the petition are in support of the removal of 29 the specific location from the expedited permitting area; 30 (3) Be signed by a number of registered voters within the specific location equal 31 to or greater than 50% of the registered voters within the specific location that 32 33 voted in the most recent gubernatorial election; and

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$28,750 in fiscal year 2013-14 and \$19,627 in fiscal year 2014-15 for one limited period one-quarter time Senior Planner position to process requests for removal of locations from the expedited permitting area. The department anticipates the position would be needed for 3 to 4 years. \$10,301 of the 2013-14 appropriation is one-time funding for rulemaking costs including room rental, mileage, advertising and legal review by the Attorney General's Office.
