COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 250, L.D. 701, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Probation and Remove References to the Intensive Supervision Program of the Department of Corrections"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 13 and 14.

Amend the bill in section 16 in §1208 by striking out all of subsections 2 to 4 (page 4, lines 34 to 40 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

2. Public restitution program; treatment program. Participation in a public restitution program or treatment program administered through a Department of Corrections' prerelease-center correctional facility; or

3. Residing at facility. Residing at a Department of Corrections' prerelease-center correctional facility for a period of time not to exceed 90 days.'

Amend the bill by adding after section 39 the following:

Sec. 40. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Adult Community Corrections 0124

Initiative: Allocates funds for the costs of processing out-of-state travel applications and the costs of extraditing probationers.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

1 **SUMMARY**

2 This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment removes  
3 the provisions of the bill regarding the termination of probation. It also removes  
4 language that authorizes a probation officer who has evidence of a probation violation to  
5 offer the defendant the opportunity to voluntarily go to jail for a period of time not to  
6 exceed 72 hours in lieu of terminating that person's probation.

7 The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill provides Other Special Revenue Funds allocations of \$10,313 in fiscal year 2013-14 and \$13,750 in fiscal year 2014-15 for the Department of Corrections.
