- 9 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{D} " to H.P. 490, L.D. 718, Bill, "An Act To 10 Protect Maine Food Consumers' Right To Know about Genetically Engineered Food and 11 Seed Stock"
- 12 Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

13 'Resolve, Directing the Commissioner of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry To 14 Petition the United States Secretary of Agriculture and the United States 15 Commissioner of Food and Drugs To Increase Consumer Confidence in Our 16 Nation's Food System'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting the following:

19 'Sec. 1. Petition. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Agriculture, Conservation 20 and Forestry shall petition the United States Secretary of Agriculture and the United 21 States Commissioner of Food and Drugs to develop a nationwide system to more fully 22 evaluate, monitor and provide for whatever labeling is considered necessary to reinforce 23 consumer confidence in the safety of our nation's food system. The commissioner shall 24 inform the secretary and the commissioner that, to date, the development of genetically 25 engineered products has focused on improving agronomic traits for the farmer, such as 26 pest and herbicide resistance and drought tolerance, and that a new generation of products 27 will improve food attributes such as fat content and increase vitamin A content. The 28 commissioner shall also inform the secretary and the commissioner that, as of this year, 25 states including Maine have introduced legislation to require the labeling of 29 30 genetically modified or engineered foods and that state-by-state initiatives of food 31 labeling will have cost implications for the consumer. The commissioner shall also 32 inform the secretary and the commissioner that, if concerns about safety, labeling or 33 contamination are not resolved at the federal level or on the international level, these new, 34 innovative and healthier products may never be commercialized; and be it further

35 Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That, upon receipt of a response from either or both 36 the United States Secretary of Agriculture and the United States Commissioner of Food 37 and Drugs, the Commissioner of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry shall forward

that response or those responses to the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry.'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is one of 2 minority reports, changes the bill into a resolve. It directs the Commissioner of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to petition the United States Secretary of Agriculture and the United States Commissioner of Food and Drugs to develop a nationwide system to more fully evaluate, monitor and provide for necessary labeling to reinforce consumer confidence in the safety of the nation's food system.
