SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 276,
L.D. 738, Bill, "An Act To Promote the Northern Maine Economy and Support Maine's
Sporting Camp Tradition"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the following:

**'Sec. 2. Lapsed balances; Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife
carrying account.** On or before June 30, 2014 and on or before June 30, 2015, the
State Controller shall lapse \$10,374 from the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Carrying
Balances - General Fund account to the General Fund unappropriated surplus to offset the
loss in revenue from changes made to moose permit fees.'

SUMMARY

This amendment lapses \$10,374 for each of fiscal years 2013-14 and 2014-15 from
the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Carrying Balances - General Fund account to the
General Fund unappropriated surplus to offset the loss in revenue from changes made to
moose permit fees.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment lapses \$10,374 in fiscal years 2013-14 and 2014-15 from the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Carrying Balances - General Fund account to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to offset the loss in revenue from changes made to moose hunting permit fees. The revenue loss is not offset in future years.
