A scrap metal processor shall provide payment to a seller only in the form of a <u>credit card</u> , as defined in <u>Title 9-A</u> , section 1-301, subsection 16, a debit card, as defined in <u>Title 10</u> , section 1271, subsection 3, or a check and. If payment is made by check, the scrap metal processor shall maintain a record of the payee, check number and name of the financial institution upon which the check is drawn.'

24 25 26 27	This amendment replaces the bill, which was a concept draft. It broadens the form of payment allowed by scrap metal processors for the purchase of scrap metal to include payment by credit card or debit card, in addition to payment by check as currently required by law.
