**Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF (FORMERLY DHS)**

**General Assistance - Reimbursement to Cities and Towns 0130**

Initiative: Deappropriates funds as a result of eliminating municipal general assistance eligibility for individuals who have reached the 60-month lifetime limit for benefits under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program or have had benefits fully terminated for noncompliance with the requirements of the program.

Includes a deappropriation of \$255,642 in 2013-14 and \$287,598 in 2014-15 in the General Assistance-Reimbursement to Cities and Towns program as a result of eliminating municipal general assistance eligibility for individuals who have reached the 60-month lifetime limit for benefits under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program or have had benefits fully terminated for noncompliance with the requirements of the program. The Governor's 2014-2015 Biennial Budget (LD 1509) includes similar initiatives.
