The bill authorizes the licensing of 12 agency liquor stores in a municipality with a population over 45,000 to provide larger municipalities with more equitable access to agency liquor stores. This amendment amends the bill to allow up to 10 agency liquor stores in a municipality with a population over 50,000.

## Fiscal Note

Minor revenue increase - General Fund

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This legislation allows up to 10 agency liquor stores in a municipality with a population over 50,000 and may result in increased General Fund revenues from issuance of increased agency store licenses. This increase is expected to be minor with no change to the budget required.
