COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 668, L.D. 955, "Resolve, Authorizing the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services To Sell or Lease the Interests of the State in Certain Real Property Located in Bangor, Boothbay Harbor and Hallowell"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 2 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "State," the following: 'in regard to the state property described in section 2,'

Amend the resolve in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "described in section 2"

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the provisions in section 1 of the resolve giving the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services authority to convey state property apply only to the properties in the City of Bangor and Town of Boothbay Harbor listed in section 2 of the resolve.
