COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 683, L.D. 969, "Resolve, Directing the Department of Health and Human Services To Reduce and Limit the Adult Developmental Services Waiting Lists by Implementing a More Efficient, Responsive and Individualized Model of Service Delivery"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 40 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "July" and inserting the following: 'October'

Amend the resolve in section 6 in the last paragraph in the 2nd line (page 3, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "current and"

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the deadline for the Department of Health and Human Services to submit the application for 2 MaineCare waivers from July 1, 2013 to October 1, 2013. This amendment also changes the goal of a maximum of 6 months for current and future waiting lists to a maximum of 6 months for future waiting lists.
