SENATE AMENDMENT “ 8 ” to S.P. 340, L.D. 995, Bill, “An Act To Establish a Moratorium on the Approval and Operation of Virtual Public Charter Schools”


Amend the bill in the emergency preamble in the 6th **Whereas** paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "126th" and inserting the following: '127th'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 8 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 8. Report. The Maine Charter School Commission shall submit a report on the review of virtual public charter schools required by section 7 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs no later than December 1, 2014. The report must include the commission's findings and recommendations and any necessary implementing legislation regarding the authorization and operation of virtual public charter schools in the State. The committee is authorized to report out a bill to the First Regular Session of the 127th Legislature related to the recommendations included in this report.'

SUMMARY

This amendment extends the reporting date from December 1, 2013 to December 1, 2014 and changes other references to reflect this change.
