HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 711,
L.D. 1013, Bill, "An Act To Create the Children's Wireless Protection Act"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §1538 by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

3. Application. This section applies only to cellular telephones sold at retail in this State.

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §1538 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the requirements governing the labeling of cellular telephones or cellular telephone packaging relating to radio-frequency exposure apply only to cellular telephones sold at retail in Maine.
