Amend the amendment in section 1 in §2355 in subsection 1 by striking out all of
paragraph B (page 1, lines 26 to 31 and page 2, line 1 in amendment)


Amend the amendment in section 1 in §2355 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the
first line (page 2, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "C." and inserting
the following: 'B.'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §2355 in subsection 2 in the first 2 lines (page
2, lines 4 and 5 in amendment) by striking out the following: "who has received opioid
overdose information identified in subsection 1"

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement that a health care professional who
prescribes naloxone to a person provide that person opioid overdose information.
