2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1866-E, sub-§6,</b> as enacted by PL 2003, c. 499, §8, is amended to read:
4 5 6 7	<b>6. Small manufacturers exempt.</b> A brewer manufacturer who produces no more than 50,000 gallons of its product or a bottler of water who sells no more than 250,000 containers each containing no more than one gallon of its product in a calendar year is exempt from the requirements of this section for that year.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill expands the exemption from the returnable beverage container laws for small brewers to all small manufacturers of beverages in the State.
