SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 390,
L.D. 1129, Bill, "An Act To Promote Innovation in Public Schools"

Amend the amendment by striking everything after the title and before the summary
and inserting the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
following:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §254, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is
amended to read:

4. Statewide conference. Annually the commissioner shall hold a conference for
~~the instruction of school board members, superintendents, school administrators,~~
educators and others, in order to share best practices and to showcase innovative
approaches to teaching and learning. Materials from the conference must be posted on
the department's publicly accessible website.

Sec. 2. Deeper learning models. By October 3, 2013, the Department of
Education shall post on its publicly accessible website examples of deeper learning
educational models and resources that can enable school administrative units to transition
to a standards-based system of education that includes proficiency-based standards for
awarding a high school diploma. The deeper learning models posted on the department's
website must exemplify best practices in the State's schools, as well as schools in other
states and jurisdictions, that represent effective strategies implemented by educators to
convey the skills, knowledge and competencies that students need to succeed in the 21st
century, including the ability to master academic content, think critically and solve
complex problems, work collaboratively, communicate effectively and learn how to
learn.

Sec. 3. Statewide conference. The Department of Education shall lead a
statewide conference held no later than June 20, 2014, and annually thereafter until 2018,
where deeper learning organizations can showcase their learning models. The department
shall use the conference to encourage school districts to work with the department to
showcase their innovations and strategies. The department and supporting organizations
and teacher preparation programs shall share strategies on how to transition and
implement standards-based learning to include experiential learning, Asia Society's


1 Partnership for Global Learning, customized learning, expanded educational
2 opportunities and any other standards-based models.

3 **Sec. 4. Teleconferences.** The Department of Education shall create a series of
4 teleconferences to be held between October 20, 2013 and June 20, 2014, and annually
5 thereafter until 2018, to support standards-based learning strategies, promote
6 implementation of standards-based learning models and provide resources to public
7 schools across the State.'

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This amendment requires the Commissioner of Education to hold an annual
10 conference for school board members, superintendents, school administrators, educators
11 and others, in order to share best practices and showcase innovative approaches to
12 teaching and learning and post materials from the conference on the department's publicly
13 accessible website.

14 The amendment also directs the Department of Education to post on its publicly
15 accessible website exemplary models and best practices of deeper learning educational
16 models and resources that can enable school administrative units to transition to a
17 standards-based system of education that includes proficiency-based standards for
18 awarding a high school diploma. In addition, the Department of Education is required to
19 hold a statewide conference no later than June 20, 2014 about standards-based or deeper
20 learning models, as well as a series of teleconferences between October 20, 2013 and
21 June 20, 2014 that will provide support for school systems throughout the State as they
22 implement standards-based learning or deeper learning models.
