Like the bill, it authorizes the council to establish the office of executive director 14 to provide leadership and management expertise to assist the council in meeting its goals, 15 but further allows the council to enter into an agreement, to the extent that public and 16 private funds are available, to contract with an executive director. 17 2. It adds the Maine Maritime Academy to the entities that jointly provide staff 18 support to the council. 19 3. It authorizes the council to receive and expend funds from public and private 20 sources to carry out the council's duties. 21 4. It reduces the General Fund appropriation from \$250,000 to \$50,000 in each year 22 of the biennium and provides that funds do not lapse but are carried forward for the

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purposes of the council.
