HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 816, L.D. 1151, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Administration and Financial Transparency of the Citizen Trade Policy Commission"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

Sec. 3. Transfer of unspent funds. At the end of fiscal year 2012-13, the Executive Director of the Legislative Council shall calculate the amount of unexpended funds appropriated, allocated or otherwise provided or made available to the Citizen Trade Policy Commission in fiscal year 2012-13 and shall transfer those unexpended funds to the account established for the commission by this Act.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires any unexpended funds of the Citizen Trade Policy Commission remaining at the end of fiscal year 2012-13 to be transferred into the separate account created in the bill.

This amendment would result in the transfer of unexpended balances of funding designated for the Citizen Trade Policy Commission from the Legislature program within the Legislature to the newly established program, the Citizen Trade Policy Commission program within the Legislature. This amendment will not affect General Fund lapsed balance, just the program in which unexpended balances would carry forward from fiscal year 2012-13 to fiscal year 2013-14. The amount of the commission's unexpended balances at the close of fiscal year 2012-13 cannot be estimated at this time.
