## Fiscal Note

Current biennium cost increase - General Fund

Current biennium cost increase - Federal Expenditures Fund

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Department of Health and Human Services may experience an increase in General Fund and Federal Expenditures Fund Medicaid costs since federally qualified health centers are reimbursed at a rate significantly higher than methadone clinics. It is likely that the additional cost to reimburse federally qualified health centers will exceed any possible transportation savings.
