HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 870, L.D. 1230, Bill, "An Act To Improve Access to Oral Health Care"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1094-FF in the first paragraph in the next to the last line (page 3, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "25%" and inserting the following: '50%'

SUMMARY

The bill allows a dental hygiene therapist to provide certain services while under the general supervision of a dentist in certain health settings, including a private dental practice that serves a population that is at least 25% patients covered by the MaineCare program or underserved adults. This amendment increases that threshold to 50%.
