COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 922, L.D. 1295, Bill, "An Act To Require the Use of Preapproved Subcontractors for Publicly Funded Construction Projects"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1743-D in subsection 2 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "listed in" and inserting the following: 'listed pursuant to'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1743-D in subsection 2 in the 6th line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "listed in" and inserting the following: 'listed pursuant to'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1743-D by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 1, lines 23 to 37 and page 2, lines 1 to 4 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

3. Project components subject to selection from preapproved list. The Director of the Bureau of General Services shall compile a list of approved subcontractors for the components of capital improvement projects based on a list of components maintained by the Bureau of General Services.'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF

Capital Construction/Repairs/Improvements - Administration 0059

Initiative: Provides funds for one part-time Architect Engineer position, one part-time Office Assistant II position and related costs to maintain and make available a list of approved subcontractors.
