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## ROFS Amend the resolution by striking out all of the question (page 1, lines 22 to 27 in 1 2 L.D.) and inserting the following: 3 "Do you favor amending the Constitution of Maine to provide that laws 4 limiting hunting or fishing may not be proposed through a citizen 5 initiative and that hunting and fishing and the taking of wildlife are a 6 valued part of our heritage that must be forever preserved and regulated 7 for the public good?" 8 **SUMMARY** 9 This amendment, which is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on 10 Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, strikes the constitutional amendment language in the bill and replaces it with constitutional language to forever preserve hunting and fishing and 11 12 the taking of wildlife subject to regulation for the public good. The amendment also 13 excludes from laws that may be proposed in a citizen initiative laws governing hunting and fishing that would limit hunting or fishing.
