**Resolve, Establishing the East-west Highway Study Commission To  
Oversee Further Study or Planning for an East-west Highway**

1           **Sec. 1. East-west Highway Study Commission established. Resolved:**  
2 That the East-west Highway Study Commission, referred to in this resolve as "the  
3 commission," is established to oversee all state participation in plans for and development  
4 of an east-west highway; and be it further

5           **Sec. 2. Commission membership. Resolved:** That the commission consists of  
6 11 members as follows:

7           1. Four members appointed by the President of the Senate as follows:

8           A. Two members of the Senate from the party holding the largest number of seats in  
9 the Senate;

10           B. One member of the Senate from the party holding the 2nd largest number of seats  
11 in the Senate; and

12           C. One member of the public who resides in the vicinity of the proposed east-west  
13 highway;

14           2. Six members appointed by the Speaker of the House as follows:

15           A. Two members of the House of Representatives from the party holding the largest  
16 number of seats in the House;

17           B. One member of the House of Representatives from the party holding the 2nd  
18 largest number of seats in the House;

19           C. Two members of the public who reside in the vicinity of the proposed east-west  
20 highway; and

21           D. One member of the public who has expertise in rail transportation; and

22           3. The Commissioner of Transportation or the commissioner's designee; and be it  
23 further

24           **Sec. 3. Chairs. Resolved:** That the first-named Senate member is the Senate  
25 chair and the first-named House of Representatives member is the House chair of the  
26 commission; and be it further

27           **Sec. 4. Appointments; convening of commission. Resolved:** That all  
28 appointments must be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this  
29 resolve. The appointing authorities shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative  
30 Council once all appointments have been completed. After appointment of all members,  
31 the chairs shall call and convene the first meeting of the commission. If 30 days or more  
32 after the effective date of this resolve a majority of but not all appointments have been  
33 made, the chairs may request authority and the Legislative Council may grant authority  
34 for the commission to meet and conduct its business; and be it further

35           **Sec. 5. Duties. Resolved:** That the commission shall consider the costs and  
36 benefits of a wide range of options and not limit its analysis to the financial feasibility of  
37 a new highway or highway upgrade project, and that alternative methods of achieving any  
38 benefits of a new highway, including rail services, must also be presented to the public

1 for comment and analyzed in the work of the commission. The commission shall hold at  
2 least 3 regional public hearings along the route of the proposed east-west transit corridor.  
3 All documents, including emails, attachments, letters, contracts, reports, records, notes,  
4 summaries, working papers, plans, interoffice and intraoffice memoranda, drafts or any  
5 other materials created, received or transmitted by the commission are subject to public  
6 review and are not confidential under any provision of Maine law; and be it further

7 **Sec. 6. Staff assistance. Resolved:** That the Legislative Council shall provide  
8 necessary staffing services to the commission; and be it further

9 **Sec. 7. Report. Resolved:** That, no later than January 15, 2014, the commission  
10 shall submit a preliminary report that includes its findings and recommendations and, no  
11 later than October 15, 2014, a final report to the Joint Standing Committee on  
12 Transportation.

13 **SUMMARY**

14 This resolve establishes the East-west Highway Study Commission to oversee further  
15 study of an east-west highway.
