SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 451,
L.D. 1308, Bill, "An Act To Establish a Stewardship Program for Architectural Paint "

Amend the amendment on page 4 by inserting before the last indented paragraph (page 4, line 37 in amendment) the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 in §2144 by striking out all of subsection 6 and inserting the following:

'6. Administration and enforcement of program. The department shall enforce this section and may adopt rules as necessary for the purposes of implementing, administering and enforcing this section. The department shall charge a reasonable fee to be paid by an applicant for approval of a paint stewardship program for review of the plan. The department may establish a reasonable annual fee to cover the actual costs for annual report review, oversight, administration and enforcement. Fees established under this subsection may not exceed the greater of \$82,000 per year and 1% of total program costs as set forth in the independent financial auditing report required under subsection 5.'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 (page 5, lines 22 to 37 and page 6, lines 1 to 23 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Provides an ongoing Other Special Revenue Funds allocation to the Department of Environmental Protection for administrative and technology costs associated with an architectural paint product stewardship program.

22 This amendment specifies that the annual fee set by the Department of Environmental
23 Protection for the paint stewardship program must cover the actual costs of the program,
24 including administration. This amendment also caps the fee at the greater of \$82,000 per
25 year and 1% of total program costs.

26 The amendment also replaces the appropriations and allocations section in
27 Committee Amendment "A."

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the General Fund appropriations of \$36,473 in FY 2013-14 and \$38,719 in FY 2014-15 and increases the Other Special Revenue Funds allocations by those same amounts to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to account for an increased annual fee related to the administration of an architectural paint product stewardship program. Fee revenue realized by DEP is estimated to cover the administrative cost associated with this program, which will be \$71,239 in FY 2013-14 and \$75,731 in FY 2014-15.
