1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2310, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected
by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

4 **§2310.** Other permitted uses for buses

11

A bus, integrally constructed, with a carrying capacity of 40 or more passengers, operated by a motor carrier holding an operator's permit issued by the Bureau of State Police or a motor vehicle with a carrying capacity of 10 to 15 passengers operated by a driver with an appropriate driver's license endorsement for a school bus designed to carry <u>15 passengers or fewer including the driver</u> may be used for school activities other than conveying children to and from home and school.

SUMMARY

12 This bill provides that a motor vehicle with a carrying capacity of 10 to 15 passengers 13 operated by a driver with an appropriate driver's license endorsement for a school bus 14 designed to carry 15 passengers or fewer including the driver may be used for school 15 activities other than conveying children to and from home and school.
