1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2310**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected
3 by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

4 **§2310. Other permitted uses for buses**

5 A bus, integrally constructed, with a carrying capacity of 40 or more passengers,
6 operated by a motor carrier holding an operator's permit issued by the Bureau of State
7 Police or a motor vehicle with a carrying capacity of 10 to 15 passengers operated by a
8 driver with an appropriate driver's license endorsement for a school bus designed to carry
9 15 passengers or fewer including the driver may be used for school activities other than
10 conveying children to and from home and school.

11 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill provides that a motor vehicle with a carrying capacity of 10 to 15 passengers
13 operated by a driver with an appropriate driver's license endorsement for a school bus
14 designed to carry 15 passengers or fewer including the driver may be used for school
15 activities other than conveying children to and from home and school.
