1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to create a college scholarship fund for postsecondary students  
6 who have left school after making considerable progress towards completion of their  
7 undergraduate degrees and who are unable to return without financial assistance.

8 The fund would be established and administered by the State, with initial funding of  
9 equal amounts from the State, universities in this State and the private sector.
