COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to S.P. 493, L.D. 1391, "Resolve, To Provide a Pesticide Spraying Notification Process"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "downward into the target canopy." and inserting the following: 'to specific targeted specimens; and be it further'

Amend the resolve by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.

This amendment is the minority report. It clarifies that air-carrier equipment used in outdoor pesticides applications does not include air-assisted application equipment in which the airstream is directed to specific targeted specimens.

The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.
