SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1024, L.D. 1435, Bill, "An Act To Amend Certain Provisions of the Fish and Wildlife Laws"

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment removes the provision in the bill that eliminated nonresident junior fishing licenses. General Fund revenue is restored by \$48,750 in fiscal year 2013-14 and \$65,000 in subsequent years.
