The history of each of the plans; 19 B. The reasoning behind, and necessity of, codifying each of the plans in the Maine 20 Revised Statutes; 21 C. The advantages and disadvantages of codifying each plan in the Maine Revised 22 Statutes: 23 D. The effect of repealing the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapters 425 and 427 on the plans and on the governance of the plans; 24 25 E. The effect on the plans of allowing certain specific provisions of the Maine Public 26 Employees Retirement System plans to be amended through the rule-making process; 27 and 28 F. Any other factors determined relevant by the Maine Public Employees Retirement 29 System. 30 2. Report. The Maine Public Employees Retirement System shall report the results 31 of its study under this section together with any recommendations to the Joint Standing 32 Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs no later than January 15, 2014. Upon receipt and review of the report, the committee may submit a bill to the Second 33 34 Regular Session of the 126th Legislature concerning the subject of the report.'
