### Fiscal Note

State Mandate - Unfunded

#### State Mandates

**Required Activity**

Requires members of the cooperative boards of career and technical education regions to be elected by voters.

**Unit Affected**

Municipality

**Local Cost**

Moderate statewide

The required local activities in this bill may represent a State mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. Unless General Fund appropriations are provided to fund at least 90% of the additional costs or a Mandate Preamble is amended to the bill and two-thirds of the members of each House vote to exempt this mandate from the funding requirement, municipalities may not be required to implement these changes.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

Additional costs to the State Board of Education and the Department of Education associated with implementing the requirements of this legislation can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
