11 Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and before the
12 summary and inserting the following:

13 'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the
14 following:

15 '**Mandate preamble.** This measure requires one or more local units of government
16 to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local
17 revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to
18 the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, 2/3 of all of the members elected to
19 each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'
