HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1079, L.D. 1509, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2014 and June 30, 2015"

Amend the amendment in Part J in subsection 5-C in the 3rd line (page 576, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$73,306,246" and inserting the following: '\$71,334,878'

Amend the amendment in Part J in subsection 5-C in the 4th line (page 576, line 31 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$85,949,391" and inserting the following: '\$83,964,862'

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part MMMMM the following:



**Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The amendment includes Department of Health and Human Services General Fund deappropriations of \$1,971,368 in fiscal year 2013-14 and \$1,984,529 in 2014-15 and increasing the transfers to revenue sharing by the amount of the deappropriations. This amendment has no net effect on the General Fund cost of the bill and a balance budget is maintained.
