HOUSE AMENDMENT "M" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1079, L.D. 1509, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2014 and June 30, 2015"

Amend the amendment in Part C in section 7 in paragraph B in subparagraph (9) in the first line (page 561, line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: "47.29%" and inserting the following: '47.26%'

Amend the amendment in Part C in section 8 in paragraph C in subparagraph (3) in the first line (page 561, line 29 in amendment) by striking out the following: "50.44%" and inserting the following: '50.41%'

Amend the amendment in Part C in section 9 in paragraph B in subparagraph (6) in the 2nd line (page 562, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "52.71%" and inserting the following: '52.74%'

Amend the amendment in Part C in section 12 in §15688-A by inserting after subsection 3 the following:

**'4. School improvement and support. The commissioner may expend and disburse funds to support school improvement activities in accordance with chapter 222.'**

Amend the amendment in Part C in section 22 in that part relating to **Enhancing Student Performance and Opportunity** in the first line (page 567, line 28 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$2,500,000" and inserting the following: '\$4,000,000'

Amend the amendment in Part C in section 22 in that part relating to **Total Cost of Funding Public Education from Kindergarten to Grade 12** in the 3rd line (page 567, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$1,992,465,619" and inserting the following: '\$1,993,965,618'

Amend the amendment in Part C in section 22 in that part relating to **Total Cost of Funding Public Education from Kindergarten to Grade 12** in the 2nd to last line (page 568, line 11 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$2,203,903,764" and inserting the following: '\$2,205,403,764'
