SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1091, L.D. 1520

SUMMARY

This amendment increases, from 16% to 24%, the percentage of the net table game income from table games operated by the Passamaquoddy Tribe that must be collected and distributed and increases, from 2% to 10%, the percentage distributed to the Coordinated Veterans Assistance Fund.

The amendment also directs the Director of the Bureau of Maine Veterans' Services within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management to seek input from veterans' organizations in the State, including the American Legion, American Veterans, Disabled American Veterans and Veterans of Foreign Wars, in distributing the table game income from the Coordinated Veterans Assistance Fund.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This floor amendment increases the tax on net table game income by 8%, from 16% to 24%, increasing Other Special Revenue Funds revenue by \$350,400 as compared to the committee amendment. The amendment distributes the additional funds to the Coordinated Veterans Assistance Fund.
